1 RESOLUTION
2 APPROVING A JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF
3 ALBUQUERQUE AND THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BERNALILLO
4 COUNTY ESTABLISHING THE MIDDLE RIO GRANDE HOUSING
5 COLLABORATIVE AND ADJUSTING FISCAL YEAR 2023 OPERATING
6 APPROPRIATIONS TO SUPPORT THE MIDDLE RIO GRANDE HOUSING
7 COLLABORATIVE.

8 WHEREAS, R-23-106, Enactment R-2023-017 declared the City's intent to
9 collaborate with Bernalillo County in the acquisition, construction,
10 rehabilitation, and provision of affordable housing for the greater benefit of all
11 residents of the City Of Albuquerque and Bernalillo County and identified
12 future actions to include exploring the viability of combining the City's
13 Housing Authority and programs with the Bernalillo County Housing
14 Department; and

15 WHEREAS, the collaborative effort called for in the approved F/S R-23-106
16 is known as the Middle Rio Grande Housing Collaborative (The Collaborative);
17 and

18 WHEREAS, a joint working committee was convened and a Joint Powers
19 Agreement has been negotiated as called for by R-23-106; and

20 WHEREAS, F/S R-23-106 approved a General Fund appropriation of five
21 hundred thousand dollars to the Family and Community Services Department
22 for the operations of the Collaborative; and

23 WHEREAS, the development of the Collaborative is still in process, and the
24 allocated funds will be needed for operations beyond June 30, 2023; and

25 WHEREAS, the City Council desires to make these funds available for the
26 original purpose of funding the operations of the Collaborative.

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1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
2 ALBUQUERQUE:

3 SECTION 1. The Joint Powers Agreement between the City of Albuquerque
4 and the County Commissioners of Bernalillo County establishing the Middle
5 Rio Grande Housing Collaborative, Exhibit A to this resolution, is approved.

6 SECTION 2. That the following amounts are hereby adjusted to the
7 following programs and funds in Fiscal Year 2023:

8 GENERAL FUND – 110

9 City Support

10 Transfer to Other Funds:

11 Operating Grants Fund (265) 500,000

12 Family and Community Services

13 Affordable Housing (500,000)

14 OPERATING GRANTS FUND – 265

15 Family and Community Services Department

16 Middle Rio Grande Housing Collaborative 500,000

17 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect five days
18 after publication by title and general summary.


