9 **MODIFYING ACCESS POINTS ON SENATOR DENNIS CHAVEZ BOULEVARD**
10 **PROVIDING AN ADDITIONAL ACCESS POINT ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF SENATOR**
11 **DENNIS CHAVEZ BOULEVARD EAST OF 118TH STREET**

13 WHEREAS, Resolutions UTPPB R-85-13, R-86-9, R-86-31, R-88-8, R-90-5, R-
14 01-24, R-05-11, R-05-14 designate Rio Bravo Boulevard (including Senator Dennis
15 Chavez Boulevard) as a high-speed, high-capacity limited access Principal Arterial
16 between I-25 and Paseo del Volcan, Western alignment and designate the allowable
17 access locations along its length; and

18 WHEREAS, this action would add a T-intersection on the south side of Senator
19 Dennis Chavez Boulevard east of 118th Street at the eastern boundary of the Atrisco
20 Heritage Academy High School; and

21 WHEREAS, Resolution R-05-09 MTB adopted policies for determining roadway
22 access modifications in the Albuquerque Metropolitan Planning Area; and

23 WHEREAS it is the responsibility of the Transportation Coordinating Committee
24 of the Metropolitan Transportation Board to affect any changes to the Limited Access
25 Roadways in the Albuquerque Metropolitan Planning Area.


26 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Transportation Coordinating
27 Committee of the Metropolitan Transportation Board of the Mid-Region Council of
28 Governments of New Mexico that the Roadway Access Policies for the Albuquerque
29 Metropolitan Planning Area are amended, as shown on Attachment "A" and as
30 described:

- 31 1. Adding a new T-intersection on the south side of Senator Dennis Chavez
32 Boulevard east of 118th Street on the eastern boundary of the Atrisco Heritage
33 Academy High School, and including all improvements indentified in **Section**
34 **VIII- Conclusions and Recommendations of the June 11, 2010 Westside**
35 **Stadium Traffic Impact Study** prepared for Albuquerque Public Schools!
