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11 **AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2013**
12 **UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM (UPWP)**
13 **FOR TRANSPORTATION PLANNING IN THE**
14 **ALBUQUERQUE METROPOLITAN PLANNING AREA**
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17 WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transportation Board (MTB) is the designated
18 Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Albuquerque Metropolitan Planning
19 Area (AMPA); and

20 WHEREAS, federal laws and regulations require an annual Unified Planning Work
21 Program that describes current transportation planning activities and those scheduled for
22 the coming fiscal year; and

23 WHEREAS, the New Mexico Department of Transportation and the metropolitan
24 planning organizations of New Mexico have agreed to change the UPWP reporting year
25 from State Fiscal Year (SFY) to the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY); and

26 WHEREAS, this amendment extends the SFY 2013 UPWP to September 30, 2013
27 to coincide with the beginning of the Federal Fiscal Year; and

28 WHEREAS, an amended FY 2013 UPWP has been prepared by the MPO staff in
29 cooperation with representatives of the U.S. Department of Transportation, the New
30 Mexico Department of Transportation, and the local transit providers: the City of
31 Albuquerque Transit Department and the Rio Metro Regional Transit District; and

32 WHEREAS, the amended FY 2013 UPWP has been reviewed and endorsed by the
33 Metropolitan Transportation Board's Transportation Coordinating Committee; and

34 WHEREAS, the MTB is responsible for all policies and related work programs of the
35 Mid-Region Metropolitan Planning Organization, including the UPWP for transportation
36 planning in the AMPA,


37 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Metropolitan Transportation Board of
38 the Mid-Region Council of Governments of New Mexico that:

39 1. The Fiscal Year 2013 Unified Planning Work Program is amended.


40 2. The Executive Director of the Mid-Region Council of Governments is authorized
41 to submit the amended Fiscal Year 2013 Unified Planning Work Program to the New
42 Mexico Department of Transportation and the U.S. Department of Transportation's Federal
43 Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration.

44 3. The Executive Director is authorized to execute the required contracts necessary
45 to implement the amended Fiscal Year 2013 Unified Planning Work Program for the
46 Albuquerque Metropolitan Planning Area.
