


## Potential Transit Routes

The City of Albuquerque and the RTD are pursuing the Central Ave. and University Blvd. BRT lines as two parts of one system, and are exploring future expansions to Paseo del Norte and other corridors. The agencies are collaborating on funding, the design of stations and busses, and to ensure that the service will be coordinated to best serve the region's transportation needs. These transit services are being considered for development and no final placement or design decisions have been made.

## What is Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)

BRT is a reliable, frequent and effortless type of transit where buses travel in dedicated lanes throughout the city, allowing them to operate with little to no interference from other traffic. In areas where dedicated lanes are not practical, buses may merge with existing traffic for short periods of time and have traffic signal priority.

This new bus rapid transit system will join dozens of other transit systems across the globe where communities desire convenience, smart investments in transit and sustainable community redevelopment.
