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11 **ADOPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2013**
12 **UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM (UPWP)**
13 **FOR TRANSPORTATION PLANNING IN THE**
14 **ALBUQUERQUE METROPOLITAN PLANNING AREA**
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17 WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transportation Board (MTB) is the designated
18 Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Albuquerque Metropolitan Planning
19 Area (AMPA); and

20 WHEREAS, federal laws and regulations require an annual Unified Planning Work
21 Program that describes current transportation planning activities and those scheduled for
22 the coming fiscal year; and

23 WHEREAS, a draft FY 2013 UPWP has been prepared by the MPO staff in
24 cooperation with representatives of the U.S. Department of Transportation, the New
25 Mexico Department of Transportation, and the local transit providers: the City of
26 Albuquerque Transit Department and the Rio Metro Regional Transit District; and

27 WHEREAS, the draft FY 2013 UPWP has been reviewed and endorsed by the
28 Metropolitan Transportation Board's Transportation Coordinating Committee; and

29 WHEREAS, the MTB is responsible for all policies and related work programs of the
30 Mid-Region Metropolitan Planning Organization, including the UPWP for transportation
31 planning in the AMPA,

32 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Metropolitan Transportation Board of
33 the Mid-Region Council of Governments of New Mexico that:

34 1. The Fiscal Year 2013 Unified Planning Work Program is adopted.

35 2. The Executive Director of the Mid-Region Council of Governments is authorized
36 to submit the final Fiscal Year 2013 Unified Planning Work Program to the New Mexico
37 Department of Transportation and the U.S. Department of Transportation's Federal
38 Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration.

39 3. The Executive Director is authorized to execute the required contracts necessary
40 to implement the Fiscal Year 2013 Unified Planning Work Program for the Albuquerque
41 Metropolitan Planning Area.
