**APPROVING THE FFY 2016-2021
TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)
FOR THE ALBUQUERQUE METROPOLITAN PLANNING AREA**

WHEREAS federal laws and regulations require metropolitan planning organizations to develop an intermodal/multimodal financially constrained Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for each metropolitan area; and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transportation Board (MTB) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Albuquerque Metropolitan Planning Area (AMPA); and

WHEREAS, *Futures 2040, the 2040 Metropolitan Transportation Plan, (2040 MTP)* has been approved by the MTB and is the long-range transportation plan for the AMPA; and

WHEREAS, the 2040 MTP and the FFY 2016-2021 TIP conform to Air Quality Plans, which include the Transportation Conformity State Implementation Plan (SIP) and the *2006-2016 Limited Maintenance Plan for Carbon Monoxide: Albuquerque-Bernalillo County* (reference resolution R-15-03 MTB); and

26 WHEREAS, the 2040 MTP provides the basis for programming projects in the
27 TIP for the AMPA; and

28 WHEREAS, the FFY 2016-2021 TIP has been developed based on the
29 contents, goals and objectives of the 2040 MTP; and

30 WHEREAS, the TIP must contain all federally-funded transportation projects in
31 the metropolitan transportation planning area prior to the distribution of funds to those
32 projects; and

33 WHEREAS, the TIP must contain all regionally significant projects in the
34 metropolitan transportation planning area regardless of the source of funding; and

35 WHEREAS, the TIP has been developed in accordance with Federal
36 Regulations (23 CFR part 450); and

37 WHEREAS, the MTB is responsible for approval of the FFY 2016-2021 TIP;

38 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Metropolitan Transportation
39 Board of the Mid-Region Council of Governments of New Mexico that:

- 40 1. The FFY 2016-2021 Transportation Improvement Program as provided in
41 ATTACHMENT A is hereby approved.
- 42 2. The Executive Director of the Mid-Region Council of Governments is
43 authorized to finalize and publish the FFY 2016-2021 TIP and submit it to
44 the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) for inclusion in
45 the State Transportation Improvement Program for transmittal to the
46 appropriate agencies in the U.S. Department of Transportation.

47 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Metropolitan Transportation Board, in
48 accordance with 23 CFR 450.334, certifies that the transportation planning process is

- 49 being conducted in accordance with all applicable requirements of:
- 50 a). 23 U.S.C. 134 and 135, 49 U.S.C. Section 5303 through 5306 and 5323(1);
 - 51 b). Sections 174 and 176(c) and (d) of the Clean Air Act as amended (42 U.S.C.
52 7504, 7506(c) and (d) and 40 CFR part 93;
 - 53 c). Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended (42 U.S.C. 2000d-1) and
54 49 CFR part 21;
 - 55 d). 49 U.S.C. 5332, prohibiting discrimination on the basis of race, color, creed,
56 national origin, sex, or age in employment or business opportunity;
 - 57 e). Section 1101(b) of the SAFETEA-LU (Pub. Law 109-59) and 49 CFR part 26
58 regarding the involvement of disadvantaged business enterprises in
59 USDOT funded projects;
 - 60 f). 23 CFR part 230, regarding the implementation of an equal employment
61 opportunity program on Federal and Federal-aid highway construction
62 contracts;
 - 63 g). The provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C.
64 12101 *et seq.*) and 49 CFR parts 27, 37, and 38;
 - 65 h). The Older Americans Act, as amended (42 U.S.C. 6101), prohibiting
66 discrimination on the basis of age in programs or activities receiving
67 Federal financial assistance;
 - 68 i). Section 324 of title 23 U.S.C. regarding the prohibition of discrimination based
69 on gender; and
 - 70 j). Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. 794) and 49 CFR part
71 27 regarding discrimination against individuals with disabilities.

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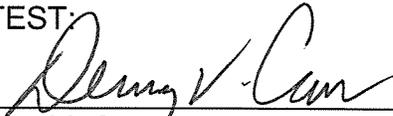
