

**OVERALL TOP THREE PLANNING PRIORITIES**

- 1st Overall Priority:** Develop the system so that people can travel to centers of employment, education and commerce easily by public transit, bicycle and walking (30% of survey takers rated this as their first priority)
- 2nd Overall Priority:** Expand and enhance public transit (14% of survey takers rated this as their first priority)
- 3rd Overall Priority:** Reduce Traffic Congestion (11% of survey takers rated this as their first priority)

**How Well the Current Transportation System Meets Needs**




**MOST SATISFIED GROUPS**

- ~ People living in Valencia County & Commuting to Albuquerque's Eastside. (% Meets needs = 38%)
- ~ People who say congestion is not a serious problem. (% Meets needs = 41%)
- ~ People who take the NM Rail Runner Express for work or school (% Meets needs = 46%)

**LEAST SATISFIED GROUPS**

- ~ People living in and commuting within Sandoval County. (% Does not meet needs = 43%)
- ~ People who report having few travel options. (% Does not meet needs = 54%)

**How Serious a Problem would you say Traffic Congestion is in your Daily Commute?**




**MOST LIKELY TO SAY CONGESTION IS NOT A SERIOUS PROBLEM**

- ~ People whose predominant mode commuting to work or school is bicycling or walking. (% Congestion not serious = 46%, 38% respectively)
- ~ People who are 35 year old and under (% Congestion is not a serious problem = 55%)

**MOST LIKELY TO SAY CONGESTION IS A SERIOUS OR VERY SERIOUS PROBLEM**

- ~ People living in Sandoval County and commuting to Albuquerque's Eastside. (% Congestion is serious or very serious = 59%)

**PEOPLE TAKING THE SURVEY WOULD LIKE BETTER ACCESS TO:**

- ~ BUS (60% Overall) Groups in particular that would like better bus access are students, people 25 years old & under, women.
- ~ TRAIN (50% Overall) Groups in particular that would like better train access are people living in Valencia Co. & Sandoval Co. that commute to Albuquerque's Eastside.
- ~ BICYCLE (36% Overall), WALK (25% Overall) Groups in particular that would like better bicycle & walk access are people living & commuting in Albuquerque's Eastside.
- ~ CAR (14% Overall) Groups in particular that would like better car access are people living in Sandoval Co. who commute to Albuquerque's Eastside & men.
