

There may be help!

Job Access Reverse Commute (JARC) is a program that provides



curb-to-curb transportation for qualified low-income residents

to get to a job site or job-training program in the Albuquerque area. Because transportation can be a major barrier to employment, Job Access was developed to overcome transportation obstacles and help people get jobs and keep jobs.

JARC provides transportation within the Albuquerque area utilizing public transportation routes that operate on fixed schedules. JARC representatives research the best options for participants and arrange transportation through ABQ RIDE or taxi services. JARC offers specialized transportation for senior citizens and individuals with disabilities. Eligible applicants must meet non-financial and financial requirements.
