Endorsement of Draft FFY 2020-2025 TIP for Formal Public Review

The Draft 2020-2025 TIP as included in the agenda package was presented by Steven Montiel, TIP Coordinator. Mr. Montiel said that all federal transportation funding is included and the process must be continuous, cooperative and comprehensive. The TIP, he said, covers six years and this new TIP will be in place by October 2019. Multimodal projects will receive higher marks when being reviewed.

Nathan Masek, MROCG Planner, presented information of the regional ITS architecture noting that it is a federal requirement.

Mr. Montiel reviewed the high points of the STP, TAP large urban, STP small urban, STP rural, NMDOT projects, and FTA funded projects.

Mr. Montiel said that formal comments will be accepted from June 18 through July 19.

Approval of Roadway Access Control Policy Revisions

Mr. Pennella presented the Roadway Access Control Policy Revisions and thanked Forest Repogle for his work on the map as well as staff from all agencies who worked on the project for the past two years.

Mr. Pennella explained that the original RAC policies were adopted in 2005. Since then the AMPA has expanded well beyond the 2005 boundaries. Additionally, agencies have identified and recommended changes in the policies due to changes in ownership, development patterns, and changing traffic patterns.

The proposed RAC policy has been reviewed by the Roadway Access Control Committee and MRMPO staff for over 2 years.

The MPO staff recommends adoption noting that the proposed policy is consistent with the 2040 MTP including the Long Range Transportation System (LRTS) and other planning documents.

The RACC has been working on this revision for two years and also recommends approval.

The TPTG and TCC reviewed the policy at their joint meeting on June 11, 2019 and unanimously recommend approval.

Mr. Pennella reviewed the highlights of the proposed revisions as follows:

1. All roads under NMDOT jurisdiction shall have access reviewed and determined by the department per the *State Access Management Manual* (SAMM) and other pertinent documents.
2. Sections of several roads that are primarily development will have access review and determination revert to the respective local government (City of Albuquerque, City of Rio Rancho, and Bernalillo County).
3. Uptown Boulevard and San Mateo Boulevard are removed from the listing of access-controlled roadways.
4. Some roads have been added to the Inventory of Roadway Access Limitations: Los Lunas River Crossing Corridor, Manzano Expressway, and Sunport Boulevard.
5. Access points along all listed routes have been reviewed and corrected if necessary.

Report on Atrisco Vista Boulevard Study

This report was heard at the beginning of the meeting.

Dave Pennington of *Parametrix* presented the briefing on the Atrisco Vista Boulevard Study. Mr. Pennington explained the importance of Atrisco Vista and the need to improve it. Those things include improved connectivity, attracting major businesses, the facilitation of orderly growth and improved road safety. Mr. Pennington also explained the history of this study and the alternative which was chosen for study. He said that Atrisco Vista Boulevard is proposed to be a limited access roadway with intersections spaced at ½ mile intervals and partial access provided about every ¼ mile such as the access on Unser Boulevard. Mr. Pennington listed the challenges affecting implementation and finally, the costs and recommended next steps. He then stood for questions.

Quarterly Project Status Report

Mr. Pennella said that it is the end of the fiscal year and several construction level projects still await PS & E. The MPO will work with Jill Mosher and Luke Smith to finalize the projects.

Approving the FFY 2020-2025 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Albuquerque Metropolitan Planning Area

Background:

The development of the FFY 2020-2025 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) was undertaken in accordance with federal regulations and the *TIP Policies and Procedures* adopted by the MTB. Please note the following:

MPO Staff Recommendation:

All proposals meet the qualifications for inclusion into the TIP and are consistent with *Futures 2040* MTP.

TPTG Recommendation:

This item was prepared by the TPTG throughout the months of January February and March and recommended by them. At the May and June meetings project funded with TAP-Small Urban, TAP-Rural, TAP-Flex, Recreational Trails Program, and CMAQ-Flex funds were added to the draft TIP upon award notices from NMDOT.

The TPTG made its initial recommendation for approval on June 11, 2019 at the joint TCC/TPTG meeting subject to the formal public review and comment, and made its final recommendation for adoption on July 9, 2019.

TCC Recommendation:

The TCC recommended endorsement of the Final Draft of the TIP at the joint TCC/TPTG meeting of June 11, 2019 subject to formal public review and comment. TCC made its final recommendation for adoption on July 12, 2019.

Public Comment:

The proposed TIP was available for public review since April 11, 2019. In addition, a formal 30-day public comment period began June 18, 2019. Any comments received will be distributed at the meeting. One comment has been received and is included in the agenda package.

14 organizations to develop an intermodal and multimodal financially constrained
15 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for each metropolitan area; and

16 WHEREAS, the Mid-Region Council of Governments (MRCOG) is the
17 designated metropolitan planning organization for the Albuquerque Metropolitan
18 Planning Area (AMPA); and

19 WHEREAS, the Mid-Region Metropolitan Planning Organization (MRMPO) is a
20 division of MRCOG responsible for the implementation of 23 CFR 450; and

21 WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transportation Board (MTB) is governing body of
22 MRMPO; and

23 WHEREAS, *Futures 2040, the 2040 Metropolitan Transportation Plan, (2040*
24 *MTP)* has been approved by the MTB and is the long-range transportation plan for the
25 AMPA; and

26 WHEREAS, the 2040 MTP provides the basis for programming projects in the

27 TIP for the AMPA; and

28 WHEREAS, the FFY 2020-2025 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) has
29 been developed based on the contents, goals and objectives of the 2040 MTP; and

30 WHEREAS, the FFY 2020-2025 TIP was developed in accordance with all
31 federal regulations (23 CFR 450) and laws; and

32 WHEREAS, the TIP must contain all federally-funded transportation projects in
33 the metropolitan transportation planning area prior to the distribution of funds to those
34 projects; and

35 WHEREAS, the TIP must contain all regionally significant projects in the
36 metropolitan transportation planning area regardless of the source of funding.

37 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Metropolitan Transportation Board
38 of the Mid-Region Metropolitan Planning Organization, a division of the Mid-Region
39 Council of Governments of New Mexico, that

- 40 1. The FFY 2020-2025 Transportation Improvement Program as presented
41 in ATTACHMENT A is hereby approved.
- 42 2. The Executive Director of the Mid-Region Council of Governments is
43 authorized to finalize and publish the FFY 2020-2025 TIP and submit it to
44 the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) for inclusion in
45 the State Transportation Improvement Program for transmittal to the
46 appropriate agencies in the U.S. Department of Transportation.

For more than 35 years, having lived in the south east heights, I have been waiting for the Gibson Corridor to be complied.

Kirtland Air Force has removed old housing and has offer to the city right of way.

The section of road (named Southern) from Eubank to Juan Tabo was specifically designed for the Gibson Corridor.

Traffic north bound on I-25 backs up from Gibson to the Big I interchange. Relief to the east is needed Gibson corridor could help this problem.

Currently Gibson East Traffic must turn north on to Louisiana to get to Wyoming, Eubank, Juan Tabo & Tramway.

The ART project and lane reductions on Zuni have increased congestion.

Completion of Gibson would reduce the congestion created by failure to complete Gibson in the past.

9 **OPEN MEETINGS RESOLUTION**

10 WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transportation Board is the governing body of the
11 Mid-Region Metropolitan Planning Organization, a division of the Mid-Region Council of
12 Governments; and

13 WHEREAS, Section 10-15-1(B) of the Open Meetings Act (Sections 10-15-1
14 through 10-15-4 NMSA 1978) states that all meetings of a quorum of members of any
15 board, commission, administrative adjudicatory body, or other policy making body of
16 any state agency, any agency or authority of any county, municipality, district, or any
17 political subdivision, held for the purpose of formulating public policy, including the
18 development of personnel policy, rules, regulations or ordinances, discussing public
19 business or for the purpose of taking any action within the authority of or the delegated
20 authority of any board, commission or other policymaking body are declared to be public
21 meetings open to the public at all times, except as otherwise provided in the constitution
22 of New Mexico or the Open Meetings Act. No public meeting, once convened, that is

33 otherwise required to be open pursuant to the Open Meetings Act shall be closed or
34 dissolved into small groups or committees for the purpose of permitting the closing of
35 the meeting; and

36 WHEREAS, Section 10-15-1 (C) allows a public body to provide members of a
37 public body to participate in a meeting of the public body by means of a conference
38 telephone or other similar communicating equipment when it is otherwise difficult or
39 impossible for the member to attend the meeting in person, provided that each member
40 participating, by conference telephone can be identified when speaking, all participants
41 are able to hear each other at the same time and members of the public attending the
42 meeting are able to hear any member of the public body who speaks during the
43 meeting; and

44 WHEREAS, Section 10-15-1(D) of the Open Meetings Act requires the Board of
45 Directors of the Mid Region Council of Governments (MRCOG) of New Mexico to
46 determine annually what constitutes reasonable notice of its public meetings; and

47 WHEREAS, Section 10-15-4 of the Open Meetings Act provides that all
48 provisions of the Open Meetings Act shall be enforced by the attorney general or by the
49 district attorney in the county of jurisdiction. However, nothing in that act shall prevent
50 an individual from independently applying for enforcement through the district courts,
51 provided that the individual first provides written notice of the claimed violation to the
52 public body and that the public body has denied or not acted on the claim within fifteen
53 days of receiving it. A public meeting held to address a claimed violation of the Open
54 Meetings Act shall include a summary of comments made at the meeting at which the
55 claimed violation occurred; and

56 WHEREAS, Section 10-15-4(c) of the Open Meetings Act provides that the
57 district courts of the state shall have jurisdiction, upon the application of any person to
58 enforce the purpose of the Open Meetings Act, by injunction, mandamus or other
59 appropriate order. The court shall award costs and reasonable attorney fees to any
60 person who is successful in bringing a court action to enforce the provisions of the Open
61 Meetings Act. If the prevailing party in a legal action brought under this section is a
62 public body defendant, it shall be awarded court costs. A public body defendant that
63 prevails in court action brought under this section shall be awarded its reasonable
64 attorney fees from the plaintiff if the plaintiff brought the action without sufficient
65 information and belief that good grounds supported it.

66 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Metropolitan Transportation
67 Board, of the Mid-Region Metropolitan Planning Organization, a division of the Mid
68 Region Council of Governments of New Mexico, that:

- 69 1. Regular meetings of the Metropolitan Transportation Board, and the
70 Transportation Coordinating Committee, shall ordinarily be held as
71 established by the individual boards at their last meeting of the calendar
72 year. For the purposes of regular meetings, notice requirements are met if
73 notice of the date, time, place, and information on how the public may
74 obtain an agenda, is placed as a legal notice in newspapers of general
75 circulation in the state at least ten (10) days in advance of the meeting
76 date. Written notice shall also be mailed to those broadcast stations
77 licensed by the Federal Communications Commission and newspapers of
78 general circulation which have made a written request of the MRCOG for

- 79 notice of public meetings. A proposed agenda will be posted in the offices
80 of the MRCOG one week before the meeting, located at 809 Copper Ave.
81 NW, Albuquerque, New Mexico; and will be available on the MRCOG
82 website at www.mrcog-nm.gov one week before the meeting; and
- 83 2. The final agenda and all supporting documents will be available in the
84 offices of the MRCOG not less than seventy-two (72) hours prior to the
85 meeting; and will be posted on the MRCOG website at [www.mrcog-](http://www.mrcog-nm.gov)
86 [nm.gov](http://www.mrcog-nm.gov) not less than seventy-two (72) hours before the meeting; and
- 87 3. Up to three (3) members of the Metropolitan Transportation Board, and
88 the Transportation Coordinating Committee, may participate by
89 conference telephone in any meetings that are held in the MRCOG
90 Conference Room; and
- 91 4. Special meetings of the Metropolitan Transportation Board, and the
92 Transportation Coordinating Committee may be called by the Chairman or
93 a majority of the members upon three (3) days notice. For the purposes of
94 special meetings, notice requirements shall be met by posting notices in
95 the offices of the MRCOG. Facsimile notice of such meetings shall be
96 provided to those broadcast stations licensed by the Federal
97 Communications Commission and newspapers of general circulation that
98 have made a written request of the MRCOG for notice of public meetings;
99 and
- 100 5. Emergency meetings of the Metropolitan Transportation Board, and the
101 Transportation Coordinating Committee are meetings called under circum-

102 stances which demand immediate action by those boards. Although the
103 boards would avoid emergency meetings whenever possible, such
104 circumstances may occasionally arise. Emergency meetings of those
105 boards may be called by the Chairman or a majority of the members upon
106 twenty-four (24) hours notice. For the purposes of emergency meetings,
107 notice requirements shall be met by posting notices in the offices of the
108 MRCOG. Facsimile notice of such meetings shall be provided to those
109 broadcast stations licensed by the Federal Communications Commission
110 and newspapers of general circulation that have made a written request of
111 the MRCOG for notice of public meetings; and

112 6. Pursuant to Section 10-15-1(H)(I) NMSA 1978, the Metropolitan
113 Transportation Board, and the Transportation Coordinating Committee
114 may close a meeting to the public if the subject matter of such discussion
115 or action is included in Subsection I of the Open Meetings Act, Section 10-
116 15-1 NMSA 1978. If any such board meeting is closed pursuant to
117 Section 10-15-1(H)(I) NMSA 1978, such closure:

118 (a) if made in an open meeting, shall be approved by a majority vote of
119 a quorum of the members of such board and authority for the
120 closure and subject to be discussed shall be stated in the motion
121 calling for the vote on a closed meeting. The vote on a closed
122 meeting shall be taken in an open meeting and the vote of each
123 individual member is to be recorded in the minutes. Only those
124 subjects announced or voted upon prior to closure by such board

125 may be discussed in a closed meeting; and
126 (b) if called for when such boards are not in an open meeting, the
127 closed meeting shall not be held until public notice, appropriate
128 under the circumstances, stating the specific provision of law
129 authorizing the closed meeting and subject matter is given to the
130 members and to the general public; and
131 6. Notwithstanding any provision, the Chairman may establish such
132 additional notice as may be deemed advisable.
