

**Place-to-Place Commuting for Persons in Poverty**

Note: The totals for CTPP Part 3 may differ slightly from other Census tabulations. The value for each cell was estimated from sample data, therefore, the sum of the cells may not equal the total for the variable. This improves the accuracy of the cell estimates but produces columns that do not add. This is a tabulation of persons who reported going to work during the week before responding to the Census (last week of March 2000). It includes both civilian and military. These tables include workers who either lived or worked in the MRCOG Region during the week prior to the 2000 Census date. Persons who were out of time for work weeks for which data are available include all areas with over 2,500 workers.

\* Many statisticians consider 30 observations to be the minimum number for generalizing to a population. The data in the CTPP has been expanded from a household sample that averages one household in 6. Therefore, a value of 180 would approximate at least 30 actual observations. Data on commutes with less than 180 cases were discarded.
