Draft goals were developed to guide the Transitions 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP).

These goals will help determine which transportation projects are best aligned with the MTP's regional vision and will therefore be selected for inclusion in the MTP.

TRANSITIONS 2045 DRAFT GOALS



Mobility Mobility refers to the efficient movement of people and goods throughout the region.



Active Transportation Active transportation modes such as biking and walking are critical for people who cannot or choose not to drive and provide healthier ways to travel.



Healthy Environment Making sure our transportation decisions support a healthy environment and take the climate change impacts into consideration.

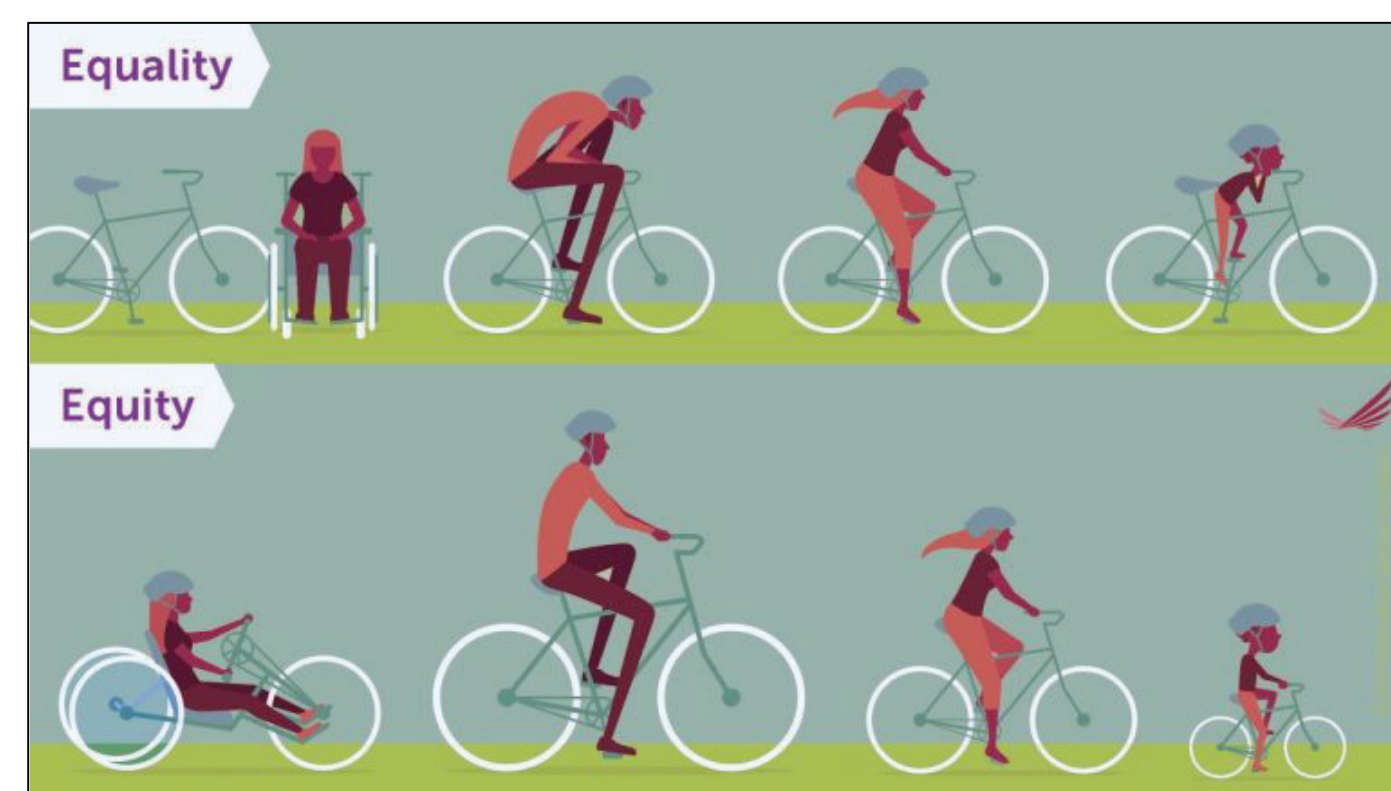


Economic Vitality Strategic transportation investments and high-quality transportation systems support the economic health of the region.



Equity Equity in transportation means providing all people what they need to be able to safely and conveniently get from Point A to Point B no matter where they live or how they get there.

MRMPO seeks to better understand the differing needs of a diverse population to help support a more equitable transportation system that works for everyone.



PUBLIC OUTREACH

The MTP is a plan that affects everyone in the region. For this reason, it is vitally important to hear from as many people and to get participation from as broad a spectrum as possible.

The public outreach plan timeline below was developed to ensure as many opportunities for residents to let us know how they feel as possible.

PHASE 1 (Sept. 2023 - Feb. 2024) Needs, Goals, Performance Measures, and Targets

Key questions we would like the public to consider during this phase:

- What is your vision for transportation in our region?
- Which are the most important issues that need to be addressed?
- What do you think about the draft goals we developed?
- How do you think we should measure progress toward achieving these goals?
- What performance targets do you think we should set?

PHASE 2 (Mar. 2024 - June 2024) Strategies, Prioritizing Needs, and Spending

Key questions we would like the public to consider during this phase:

- What strategies do you think would be most effective for addressing the region's transportation needs?
- What are your spending priorities for transportation funding?
- Which transportation-related needs should be prioritized?

PHASE 3 (June 2024 - Mar. 2024) Project Prioritization and Draft Review

Key questions we would like the public to consider during this phase:

- Which projects do you think should be prioritized?
- Do you believe the Draft MTP will help meet the identified needs of our transportation system?
- Do you feel equity-related issues are adequately addressed in the Draft MTP?

MTP DEVELOPMENT TIMELINE

- 2023**
Development of MTP Goals and Objectives. Review of current socioeconomic data, growth information, and existing transportation networks. Exploration of current transportation trends in the region. Kick off meetings with the local agencies and the public.
- 2024**
Forecasting future growth and travel demand. Considering future transportation investments and prioritizing needs. Measuring performance of system-wide improvements.
- 2025**
Final round of feedback on Draft MTP from agencies and public. Finalizing project list and financials. Finalizing MTP document. Metropolitan Transportation Board approval in April 2025.
